- Sporty Adventures - keep fit and have fun trying various sports

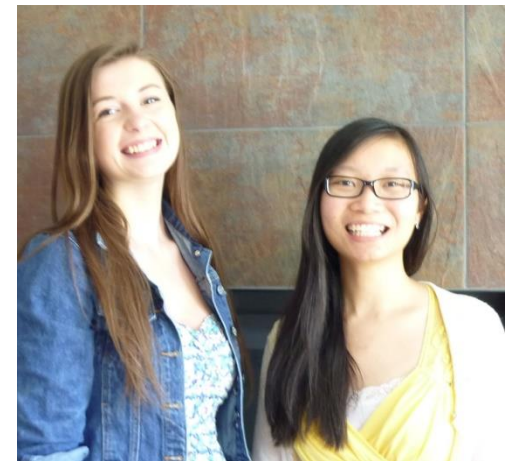
