

History

Members of the Canadian Federation of University Women/Kanata authorized the Scholarship Trust in November 2001.

On February 6, 2006, the CFUW/Kanata Scholarship Trust became a Registered Charity.

The Trust consists of up to five members of CFUW/Kanata, who are appointed by the Club's executive for a three-year term, renewable for a second term.

Each year CFUW/Kanata awards \$2000 scholarships to each of two graduating female students from the local high schools who will be attending a Canadian university.

A \$1000 bursary is also awarded to a female student who will be attending a provincially funded college.



Criteria for Scholarships

Each of the seven local high schools in Kanata, Stittsville and West Carleton is asked to submit the application of one female student who will be attending university and one who will be attending college. The criteria includes based on the student's need for financial assistance, community involvement, her ability to overcome great personal challenges, and her acceptance to a university/college of her choice. From these applications, the Scholarship Committee selects two young women going to university and one to college that they feel have the most need of the scholarships/bursary.

Fundraising

The Trust receives its funding through donations and bequests from club members and the community.

CFUW/Kanata organizes many activities that benefit the Trust. Over the past several years these have included:
